- 1. The Heaston scholarships will be awarded to students with the equivalent of high school senior status. Students must be enrolled and entering a college program in the coming academic year. All funds disbursed are to be used for school-related expenses. Applications are due February 1 and scholarship awards will be announced March 31.
- 2. The UCT Scholarship Program, funded by UCT Charities, is available to the general public and provides scholarships to students and teachers seeking college degrees or certification to work with people with intellectual disabilities. Applicants must meet specific guidelines.
- 3. The May E. Tisdale Scholarship Fund is for members only and grants scholarships to the children and grandchildren of members. Children and grandchildren of members may apply for a scholarship from the May E. Tisdale Scholarship Fund.
