## The 2016 UCT International Annual Meeting - Jerry Giff

The 2016 UCT International Annual meetings took place in Louisville Kentucky July 3rd to 6th, 2016. Sudbury Council played a very active role in supporting the convention service project of new books for the Kosair Charities foundation. Sudbury executive and members joined forces to obtain over 1000 books that were donated to this charity in Louisville. Several years ago UCT took the initiative to leave their image on each host city and annually select a local charity to receive very generous donations from all across North America. Watch for an article in the next issue of the Sample Case which will highlight the Sudbury donation.

Sudbury Council was also front and centre in local council awards. Sudbury has received the Gold Medal of Honour again for 2015-2016. This would be approximately the tenth consecutive year that Sudbury has achieved this status. This year there were only three councils throughout the ACT/UCT Region that were recognized in this manner for their community involvement and seven in all of Canada. Thanks to Claire Sheridan for developing the presentation on behalf of Sudbury council.

Our Sudbury newsletter once again received an award for the professional presentation of the publication. Thanks goes out to members Sherry and Dan Laframboise of Orion Printing for their assistance in preparing the monthly publication.

Jerry Giff completed his six year term on the International

Board of Governors and was awarded the designation of Past International President.

Doug Honeyford attending his first International meeting was placed on several committees by President Gordon Woodworth from Halifax, for the upcoming year. Doug will chair the Canadian Operations Task Force and the International Membership Committee. Doug was also elected to the Board of the Canadian Delegation comprised of all Canadian UCT members. We know Doug will do an outstanding job and represent Sudbury and ACT/UCT well at these annual UCT meetings. Congratulations Doug on your appointments.

We also returned with a video that explains the use and value of the Kaye Trainer. The Kaye Trainer International Capital Campaign was kicked off in 2014 with a goal of purchasing 80 units or a total of \$200,000. The Kaye Trainer is a physical therapy device used in rehabilitation centres worldwide. Special hockey programs for those players with physical challenges have identified an alternative use for the device. The device is identified as "THE safest way to teach someone how to skate". The 80 units will provide one to every special hockey program in the USA and Canada.
