R.S.V.P. is required.

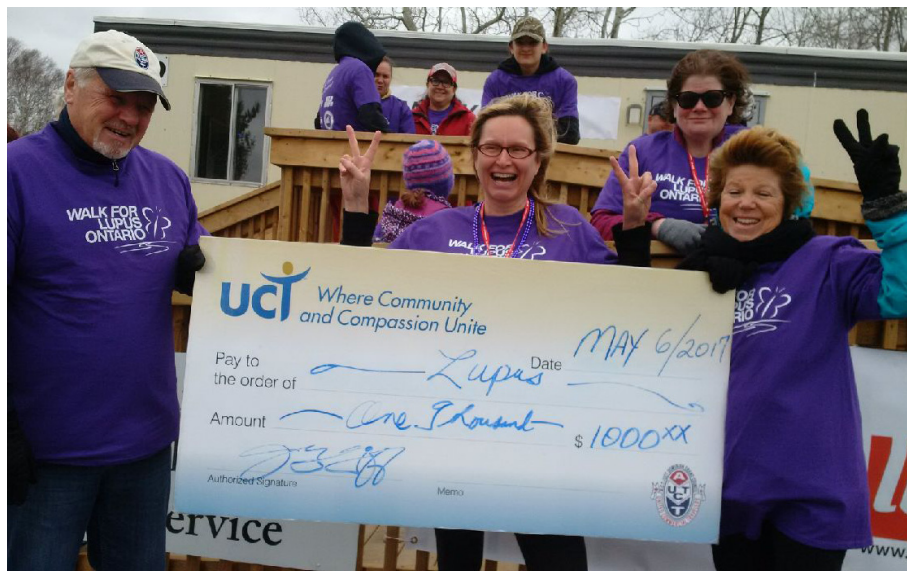
