UCT now offers online payment option for Canadian members

Dear UCT Member,

UCT is pleased to offer a new way to pay for your membership dues via Interac e-Transfer.

Click on the link below to see an overview of Interac e-Transfer on how to send money directly to UCT using your online or mobile banking. Make sure to scroll down to check out the short video in the link as well.

Interac - For Consumers

Interac e-Transfer is a great alternative to cheques and cash. Canadians are using it to simplify their everyday person-to-person payments. All you need is access to online or mobile banking through a participating financial institution, and you can send money to anyone with an email address without sharing any personal financial information.

When submitting your online payment make sure to include your policy number in the email to <u>jpierre@uct.org</u>. As well when setting up your security question, make sure to include the answer to the security question in your email to Joyce or contact Joyce with the answer, which allows UCT to accept the Interac e-Transfer.

UCT will still continue to accept all methods of payment such as cheque or credit card but now you have the added option to pay via Interac e-Transfer through your online or mobile banking platform.
